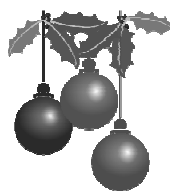


Announcements— December 1 & 2, 2018

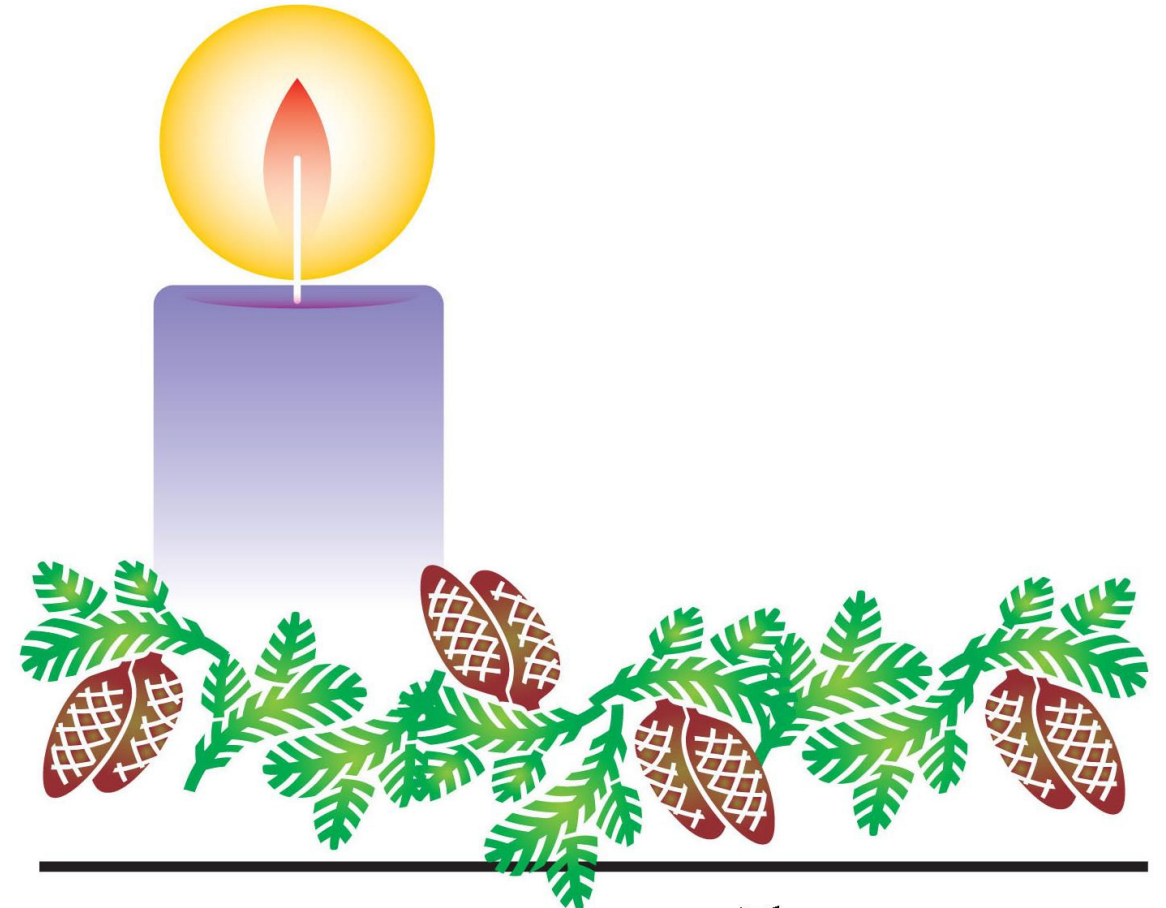
